SUBJECT: Hinds County Patriot Day Observance

On Friday, September 11, 2015, at 3:00 p.m., the Hinds County Patriot Day Observance will be held on the front lawn of the Hinds County Courthouse located at 407 East Pascagoula Street, in Jackson, Mississippi. Patriot Day is observed as the National Day of Service and Remembrance in memory of the 2,977 individuals killed in the 2001 September 11 attacks.

During the ceremony the correct manner of disposing a worn American Flag will be performed. Citizens are invited to bring their worn American Flags to the Hinds County Courthouse for proper disposal. The Hinds County Courthouse received a donated Flag Repository from the WoodmenLife. During the program we will encourage residents and businesses to utilize the Flag Repository for the disposal of worn American Flags.

The Boy Scouts along with Veteran's Organizations, local firemen, and other civic organizations will be available for participation in the ceremony. The Boy Scouts will conclude the program with a Flag Retirement Ceremony. The public is invited.
