

MOBILE HOME FINAL INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS

- Final documentation from the Mississippi Department of Health for the treatment system. **(ALL PLUMBING CONNECTIONS MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE REQUESTING A FINAL INSPECTION.)**
- There should be no furniture or appliances in the mobile home prior to final inspection.
- Must have the State Fire Marshall's sticker placed on the mobile home.
- Steps should be located at the front and rear of the mobile home.
- There should be **NO** skirting place around the mobile home until after the inspection.
- **ALL** electrical work has been completed. Example: Pole and meter base has been installed wiring to the mobile home has been completed, and breaker panel has been labeled. Should be equipped with GFI connections, or arc fault breakers for safety.
- Establish an Entergy account and have information available when scheduling the final inspection.
- Address should be place on the mobile home and/or mailbox per the E-911 system.
- All newer mobile home should have smoke detectors that are interconnected. **Older mobile homes should have battery installed smoke detectors if they were not purchased with any.**

Once **ALL** items listed above have been completed a final inspection can be scheduled.
