Dear Taxpayers of Hinds County

This office is responsible for assessing all Personal Property in Hinds County. To complete our records on our Personal Property it is necessary that we obtain information from you to correctly place an assessment on the County Tax Roll each year.

All Personal Property located at a warehouse (inventories) as required by Law Mississippi Code of 1972, Section 27-35-23 is required to report to this office (The Tax Assessor's office) a complete list of the names of your customers, including mailing addresses and the inventory information as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. January 15<sup>th</sup> is the deadline for receiving this listing.

Each licensee shall pay to the Governing Authorities for each license issued a fee in the amount of \$10.00 House Bill 1075. This should be done each year and this should be filed and received by the deadline of January 15<sup>th</sup> of each year.

Our office has received your reporting information, however we have no record of a Freeport License in place at this location. Therefore, all inventory reported will be fully taxable.
