Dear Teacher:

It's time again for the Hinds County Soil and Water Conservation District's annual essay contest. This opportunity supplements your conservation objectives in the curriculum. The essay contest is for the 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grades. Included with this letter is a set of rules. Each essay will be judged separately by a committee of educators and volunteers.

The theme for the contest this year, as chosen by the national and state conservation associations, is "**Local Heroes-Your Hardworking Pollinators**". The theme emphasizes the importance of pollinators in our daily lives. Essay ideas relating to the theme are included in the rules with websites.

**Any teacher from any subject area may submit essays** i.e. science, social studies, English. Please submit all entries; do not prejudge essays. We have judges who will select the school and county winners according to the criteria. Certificates will be given to the top three winners from each grade at each school. The first place essays from each grade in each school will then be judged in the overall county contest. The essays in the county contest will be judged in the following categories to correlate with the area and state contests: 7th & 8th, 9th & 10th, and 11th & 12th. Cash prizes and certificates will be awarded to the First, Second and Third place **overall county winners** in each category. **Prize money for county winners are as follows- 1<sup>st</sup> place- \$40.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> place- \$30.00 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place- \$20.00.**

In order for the contest to be successful, so that the students realize their stewardship responsibility, we must count on you, the educator, to promote the contest.
