If you noticed an increase in your tag price it is due to the legislative tag credit decrease from 6.5% to 5%.

The Legislators adopted HB 859 which decreases the interest on delinquent taxes from 1% to .50%.

Property tax notices will be mailed in December. Taxes are due by Feb. 1, 2021 without interest.

We are strongly encouraging the community to continue to utilize the US mail or the online alternative for current tag renewals by visiting www.hindscountyms.com. Payments and completed, signed disabled placard applications can be mailed to: P.O. Box 1727, Jackson, MS 39215. Be sure to include a phone number where you can be reached.

New tag registrations and tags outside of the grace period cannot be processed online.

Online tag renewal:

The vendor charges a non-refundable convenience fee to process payments. There is a **\$2.25** convenience fee when using a debit card in the office. A **2.25%** convenience fee for all in office or online credit card transactions. There is a \$75,000 limit when using online services: www.hindscountyms.com

Forms of Payment

We accept cash, money orders, checks, debit and credit cards. **Decals/plates paid for by check will be mailed out after 10 business days.** However, you will be given a copy of your registration at the time of purchase.

*******Have you heard about SB 2578???*****

MCA 27-33-75 amends Homestead Exemption Law for qualifying applicants currently receiving the 65 and over, effective January 2019. Applicants may be exempt on any assessed value above a base year value established the first year they become eligible for homestead exemption. Increases in assessed value related to reappraisal are exempt. Increases in assessed value due to renovations, expansions, etc. would increase the base year assessed value.

Penalty fees for late registration/ renewal:

You have 7 business days after purchasing a vehicle in state to register the vehicle. On the 8th business day there is a 5% penalty. If you purchase a vehicle out of state, you have 7 working days plus 48 hours to register the vehicle.

The penalty for late tag renewal is 5% after the first 15 days the tag is due. There is an additional penalty of 5% for each additional 30 days the tag remains overdue. The maximum penalty is 25%. Once you reach the 25% penalty you will not be allowed any Legislative Tag Credit.

Reminders:

*Vehicle registration renewal cards are mailed as a courtesy reminder. You are responsible for renewing your vehicle's registration even if the reminder card is not received.

You can receive tag notices electronically by email. Add your email address to your account when you come to register your vehicle or call our office.

*The Tax Collector's office is not responsible for items, once they are mailed out of the office.

*Please verify your address during all transactions and notify us of mailing address changes for vehicle registrations only at 601-968-6588. Changes cannot be made online.

* Check the website or call our office for accurate payment amounts after interest has been added for late renewals or property tax payments. This will eliminate having your check returned due to incorrect payment amounts.





Ingredients: I 8 oz. tube of crescent roll or crescent roll sheet. 12 oz. cream cheese softened to room temperature. 3/4 cup granulated sugar, divided use. I tsp. vanilla extract. I 21 oz. can of cherry pie filling. 1/8 cup unsalted butter, melted. * Any pie filling: apple, blackberry, strawberry, etc., works well.

Directions: Preheat oven to 350. Spray 8 x8 baking dish with nonstick cooking spray. Unroll crescent rolls and line the bottom of the baking dish until covered without gaps. Combine cream cheese and I/2 cup of sugar. Beat with an electric mixer until smooth. Then add vanilla extract and mix again. Spread cream cheese mixture over crescent rolls then pour pie filling over cream cheese and spread evenly. Finally, top with remaining crescent roll dough. Do your best to stretch it out on top and seal the seams. Pour or brush on melted butter. Bake 35-45 minutes. Top crust should look crusty and be golden brown in color. Slice and serve. Refrigerate leftovers.
