The Legislators adopted HB 859 which decreases the interest on delinquent taxes from 1% to .50% after February 1.

Continue to utilize the US mail or the online alternative (www.hindscountymys.com) for current tag renewals by visiting www.hindscountymys.com. Property payments, registration renewals, and completed, signed disabled placard applications can be mailed to: P.O. Box 1727, Jackson, MS 39215. Be sure to include license plate number, parcel number and phone number where you can be reached when mailing in information.

Partial property payments, new tag registrations and tags outside of the grace period cannot be processed online.

Verify your mailing address during all transactions and notify us of address changes. Only the registered owner can request an address change for vehicle registrations.

Contact the Chancery Clerk's Office concerning 2020 and prior year taxes beginning the 2nd week of October.

Online tag renewal:

The vendor charges a non-refundable convenience fee to process payments. There is a **\$2.25** convenience fee when using a debit card in the office. A **2.25%** convenience fee for all in office or online credit card transactions. There is a \$75,000 limit when using online services: www.hindscountymys.com

Forms of Payment

We accept cash, money orders, checks, debit and credit cards. **Decals/plates paid for with a check will be mailed after 10 business days.** However, you will be given a copy of your registration at the time of purchase.

Formas de Pago

Change of address:

To update your mailing address for vehicle registration, contact our office; this change can not be completed online.

Recently moved into the State?

You have 30 days to register your vehicle after moving into the state . If not registered within 30 days a \$250 fee will be added to the cost of registration.

*****Have you heard about SB 2764???*****

Senate Bill 2764 creates a communication Impaired Decal for those individuals that have a health condition or disability that limits or impair the ability to effectively communicate with law enforcement. The tax collector's will issue the special decals for license plate and windshield. An application has been created for the physician to complete and will be on the MS Department of Revenue website as of the effective date of January 1, 2021.

Penalty fees for late registration/renewal:

You have 7 business days after purchasing a vehicle in state to register the vehicle. On the 8th business day there is a 5% penalty. If you purchase a vehicle out of state, you have 7 working days plus 48 hours to register the vehicle.

The penalty for late tag renewal is 5% after the first 15 days the tag is due. There is an additional penalty of 5% for each additional 30 days the tag remains overdue. The maximum penalty is 25%. Once you reach the 25% penalty you will not be allowed any Legislative Tag Credit.

TUSCAN SALMON



Ingredients: 4 salmon fillets, 2 tsp. olive oil, 2tbsp butter, 5 garlic cloves, diced finely,
1 small yellow onion, diced, 1/3 cup of vegetable broth, 5 oz jarred sun-dried tomato in oil, drained, or fresh grape tomatoes, 1 3/4 cups heavy cream, salt and pepper to taste, 3 cups baby spinach, 1/2 cup grated parmesan cheese, 1 tbsp. fresh chopped parsley for garnish (optional)

Directions: Heat oil in large skillet over medium heat. Season salmon on both sides, then sear in hot pan, flesh side down for 5 minutes, then repeat on other side. Remove from pan and set aside. Do not clean pan. In same pan melt butter over medium heat, add onion and saute. Add sun-dried tomatoes and saute 1-2 min. Pour in vegetable broth and allow the sauce to reduce down slowly. Reduce heat to low, add heavy cream, and bring to low simmer, stirring often. Season cream sauce with salt and pepper.. Add baby spinach and allow to wilt. Add parm cheese and allow to melt. Add salmon back to pan, sprinkle with parsley and spoon sauce over each fillet. Serve over rice or pasta.

Reminders:

*Vehicle registration renewal cards are mailed as a courtesy reminder. *You are responsible for renewing your vehicle's registration even if the reminder card is not received.*

You can receive tag notices electronically by email. Add your email address to your account when you come to register your vehicle or call our office.

*The Tax Collector's office is not responsible for tag decals, registration renewal or property notices, etc., once they have been mailed.

***Please verify your address during all transactions and notify us of mailing address changes for vehicle registrations ONLY at 601-968-6588. Changes cannot be made online.**

* Check the website or call our office for accurate payment amounts after interest has been added for late renewals or property tax payments. This will eliminate having your check returned due to incorrect payment amounts.
